
Well-organised setting up process, with great efficiency. Blaze Away

This was played with sensitivity and musicality. The spirit of the music was clearly presented. Maintain this when playing very quietly. Brown Eyes - Disciplined

performance with sincerity. Solo lines were stylish. Occasional lapse in harmonic clarity.

More balance discipline required in some phrases. Crescendos enthusiastic rather than musically controlled. Lots of warmth and honesty.
